Before Apollo's health-giving son was transferred to the constellations as Ophiuchus ("serpent-bearer"), he had swum from his Epidaurian pilgrimage temple to Rome in the shape of a serpent bringing blessings. The reptile writhing up his staff in spiral coils has remained the most striking symbol of medicine to this day. Epidauros, c. 350 BC.
